# Kiri + Lou

A feisty little girl dinosaur, who loves to run around in the forest and swing on vines. Kiri is fearless and wild and has trouble controlling her emotions. But she's a fiercely loyal friend to Lou.



## Lou

A gentle boy creature with a long stretchy trunk, Lou is thoughtful and a kind and calming influence on Kiri. He loves napping and smelling flowers.

## Sorry

A small and extremely fast little animal, who cares about everyone's feelings.

## Pania

A large eccentric dinosaur, Pania is like a mother to Kiri and Lou, giving them advice and helping them to resolve problems. She eats a lot of leaves and has a problem with flatulence.

## Dalvanius

A very sensitive creature, who is so good at camouflage, he disappears completely whenever he is feeling shy.
